They plan to use the funds to provide programs, taught by community role models that inspire the current generation of Nebraska's Kindergarten through 12th grade students, to be financially capable and equipped to run businesses, lead nations, make discoveries and change the world.

Nominations for the *2017 Community First Awards* were open to the public in July. The nominations were then evaluated based on the nonprofit's impact on community needs and positive presence in the community. The finalists were presented for a public vote between August 28 and September 8. One winner and one runner-up have been selected from each of the following areas: Nebraska/South Dakota, Kansas, Illinois and Colorado. The winning nonprofits in each area will receive a \$10,000 cash donation and the runners-up a \$2,500 cash donation. Overall, a total of 469 nominations were received and more than 33,500 public votes were cast. First National Bank of Omaha will donate a total of \$50,000 to the *Community First Awards* recipients.
